This training scholarship will be awarded by the South Carolina Jail Administrators Association to a deserving member in good standing. This scholarship will be awarded annually and will be rotated amongst counties.

The goal of the **South Carolina Jail Administrators Association (SCJAA)** and **National Jail Leadership Command Academy (NJLCA)** is to provide training for succession preparation, and to develop leadership skills for successful transitioning of mid-level managers into senior leadership positions within jails.

The Academy curriculum was developed by the **Correctional Management Institute of Texas (CMIT)** in coordination with **American Jail Association (AJA)**, and in consultation with subject-matter experts, curriculum specialists, and educational professionals from across the country. Curriculum topics include:

- Applied Ethical Leadership
- Collaborative Partnerships
- Finance and Budget
- Essential Leadership Skills/Tools
- The Critical Key to Effective Leadership

- Big-picture Thinking

This current scholarship will be awarded to one accepted participant of the 31st session of the NJLCA to be held March 3-8, 2019 at the Correctional Management Institute of Texas (CMIT), George J. Beto Criminal Justice Center at Sam Houston State University (SHSU) in Huntsville, Texas. The scholarship is for tuition only (which includes all class materials, lodging, and all meals/snacks – \$1,960). Transportation between the George Bush Intercontinental Airport in Houston and the SHSU campus will be the recipient's responsibility.
